<b>Job Summary</b>	This is a seasonal position working part time hours, with possibilities of covering any shift. The primary responsibility of this role is the operation of water treatment equipment in order to meet established standards for animal exhibits. Technicians will operate equipment, complete system checks verifying correct operation, interpret collected data and effectively troubleshoot any conditions that are outside of the acceptable range. Technicians are also expected to assist with routine exhibit pool cleanings. This role adheres to strict water quality and operational standards which are the basis of our aquatic animal health program.
