<b>Essential Functions</b>	<p>Job scope: - Manages and monitors the operations and maintenance of the automated life support control systems and water treatment facilities, which include software, hardware, and support equipment. - Responsible for the long term planning of ALSS maintenance equipment/facilities, inspection, repair, and installation. - Monitors the trainings and development of all colleagues in the section and ensures that they acquired the required certifications and evaluates their competency level. - Ensures all life support systems and water treatment facilities are operating within all environmental and departmental regulations. • Establishes and implements ALSS SOPs, checklists, forms and other documentations. - Reviews and analyzes the daily reports and paperwork from the team, collates the data and creates the strategic plan for the team for the improvements of their efficiencies. - Communicates to other necessary departments of the ALSS related issues that impacts the park's operations and give a timely update.
